



Welcome to Bloomsburg Fair Camping!

To ensure a safe environment for all campers and visitors, The Bloomsburg Fair Association, Board of Directors, hereinafter called "FAIR" have approved the following policies to be enforced on all Fair-owned, rented, or leased property during your visit, stay of the annual Fair and non-Fair events. To maintain a family atmosphere at all times, Bloomsburg Fair Security has been directed to act as an agent to enforce these policies on behalf of The FAIR. The Town of Bloomsburg, Columbia County Sheriff's Department, and Pennsylvania State Police are also permitted to implement these policies on behalf of The FAIR when they are present on the grounds. Persons entering the facility, and the grounds assume all risks incidental to the event. While visiting or staying at any of our campgrounds or at any events on the The Bloomsburg Fair properties, please ensure you are familiar with and understand The Bloomsburg Fair General Rules and Policies <https://bloomsburgfair.com/rules/> along with the following Campground Reservations, Rules and Policies:

CAMPING REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

- ❖ Bloomsburg Fair Week Camping - **Boone's Dam Camping Available Only During Fair Week:**
 - Check - In 11:00 AM to 6:00 PM
 - Check - Out 10:00 AM
 - After check-out, if you would like to remain on the grounds for the day, please move your RV or camper to the designated area indicated by the attendant to receive a complimentary parking pass. Please note that if the vehicle is not removed from the campsite by 10:00 AM, an additional night's fee will be applied
 - \$40 / Night - Campers and RV's
 - \$15 / Night - Tents in Designated Tent Area ONLY
 - Campsites first come - first served - based on reservations. *(Unless noted in your paperwork)*
 - General Admission Camping is an **open-area camping** option available on a first-come, first-served basis. Campsites cannot be reserved, and there are no water or electric hookups. The camping area is unmarked and does not contain designated sites; group camping is permitted if space allows upon arrival.
 - In reserved camping area - Amenities: Water Hook-Up is limited and cannot be reserved.
 - **NO ELECTRICITY AT ANY SITES**

RESERVATIONS:

- All Camp Sites are First Come, First Serve. We will do the best we can to accommodate your requests but cannot guarantee.
- Reservations will be accepted in the order they are received – Mail or Email
- Payment is Due at time of Reservation
- Camping Permits will not be issued to anyone under 18 years of age. Groups of campers under 18 years of age must have at least one (1) member over 18 years of age per campsite to register with and to accompany the camper at all times.
- The individual whose name appears on the reservation as the applicant is responsible for all members of the group and must be present at the campsite
- At time of arrival, please register at the campsite office and pick up your packet and permits **before** going to the campsite.
- Upon registration, camper must provide attendants with driver's license, camper/motor home and tow vehicle registration and a phone number where they can be reached in case of an emergency
- Camping is at your own risk - The Bloomsburg Fair is not responsible for any accidents or damage to property while camping, staying or visiting the campground or fairgrounds property.

CAMPSITE OCCUPANCY:

- Campsite occupancy is limited to a maximum number of eight (8) people per campsite, including visitors.
- Persons camping under eighteen (18) years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- Children may not be left unattended in the campground without adult supervision.
- Visitors are subject to all Bloomsburg Fair Rules and Policies along with Campground Rules, Regulations and Restrictions.

VEHICLES:

- Maximum of One (1) Vehicle is permitted on any Campsite at one time.
- Parking Permit must match Campsite - RV/Trailer and Spot - and Displayed at all times.
- Any additional vehicles must be parked in the designated overflow parking lot. There is a \$10/ per day fee during Fair Week at Boones Dam. **(Sept. 25th thru Oct. 3rd, 2026)** See attendant for parking pass - Paid parking pass must be displayed. Violators will be towed at their own expense.
- No parking on the roadways

VEHICLES continued:

- Sleeping in Vehicles is **not permitted** on Fairgrounds property.
- Daily Parking Passes are only valid until Midnight of the day they purchased the ticket.
- Speed Limit is 5 mph.

AMENITIES:

- Bloomsburg Fair Week - Boone's Dam Camping - First Come, First Serve
- Limited Water / No Electric / DO NOT BLOCK WATER SPIGOTS
- Generators - Must be turned off at 10:00 PM and can be restarted at 7:00 AM - If you require a generator to be used all night long, please make note when registering. .
- Water Spigots are SHARED and provided at limited spots at a first come first serve - DO NOT BLOCK THE SPIGOTS.
- Swimming Pools of any kind are strictly prohibited.
- No filling of truck beds or any other pools with water from Bloomsburg Fair spigots.
- Washing pets is prohibited.
- Adapters - The Bloomsburg Fair is not responsible for providing adapters for electrical hook-ups. Please see form in packet for options.
- All campers are required to properly contain and dispose of all wastewaters—including gray water and black water, in accordance with state law and campground regulations. **Vendors available for sewage cleanout: Beaver Valley Environmental, Starr's and Biro's (Hand-out Provided)**
 - **Gray Water** (from washing dishes, food preparation, bathing, or hand washing) must be collected and disposed of at the campground's designated dump station or approved vendor. **Drain hoses may not be discharged onto the ground under any circumstances.**
 - **Black Water / Septic Waste - Pump-out services can be arranged through one of our approved vendors**, listed in your camper packet.
 - **Ground Discharge Prohibited** — Campers are responsible for preventing all wastewater—gray or black—from leaking, draining, or running onto the ground at any time.
 - **RV and Portable Units** — Wastewater from RVs, portable toilets, portable showers, and similar equipment must be contained in proper holding tanks until it is disposed of at the dump station or removed via an approved vendor pump-out.
 - Washing vehicles, camping equipment, or anything that produces gray water to be discharged on or around the campsite is prohibited.

QUIET HOURS:

- Quiet Hours are observed from 10:00 PM until 7:00 AM the following morning. Failure to observe this rule may result in eviction from the campground.
- Any unreasonably loud noise is prohibited at any time.

PETS: (Please see Fair Policy on Pet Rules - <https://bloomsburgfair.com/rules/>)

- PPP / Pets on Premise Permit - Please advise if there will be a pet on the premises.
 - Permits will be distributed, enforced and must be displayed at all times.
- Please carry proof of vaccinations with you if you have a pet on premise.
- Wild, exotic, vicious and/or aggressive pets and livestock are not permitted in the campground.
- Excessive barking or disturbance by pets is prohibited at any time
- **ANIMALS MUST BE ON A LEASH - NO EXCEPTIONS**
- Pet owners must dispose of all pet waste in dumpsters or pet doggie clean-up stations.
- Additional fees will be applied if animal waste is left at the campsite.
- Do not leave pets unattended
- You are responsible and liable for your pet at all times.

GENERAL RULES:

- Common Courtesy - Do not cross over or walk through other campsites.
- To help keep our campground a friendly and enjoyable place for everyone, we ask that guests use considerate language while on the grounds. Please avoid loud, harsh, or offensive words that may disturb nearby campers. We appreciate your cooperation in helping maintain a positive, family-friendly atmosphere.
- Fireworks, Firearms, Explosives and Projectile-Firing Devices are prohibited
- No fire rings, fire pits or open fires allowed
- Garbage must be placed in the dumpsters which are located throughout the camping area.
- Campsites must be kept clean during occupancy and cleaned upon departure.
- Do not leave garbage bags on the site.
- If the campsite is not left clean upon departure, a clean-up fee will be imposed.
- NO REFUNDS
- Management reserves the right to evict any and all violators of the rules and regulations without refunds and to remove persons or animals which are considered detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of management or others using the campground and facilities.
- It is further agreed that any breach by the camper or camper's guest of the rules and regulations shall constitute grounds for immediate eviction from the campground with no refund of fees
